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City introduces new annual parking permit placard

As part of the migration of the Cerritos parking permit program to an internet-based solution, the City has introduced a new annual parking permit placard, which replaces the previous sticker permit. In order to receive the new placard, residents must return their current annual parking permit sticker.

Residents are encouraged to exchange their parking permit sticker for a new placard at the Community Safety Services counter inside the Cerritos Sheriff's Station. The parking permit sticker can be exchanged by mail, however, removing the sticker before displaying the placard in one's vehicle could result in a parking citation if no permit is displayed.

Residents with a parking placard are allowed to park any of their vehicles on the street as long as those vehicles are listed on their annual parking permit application. The criteria for obtaining an annual parking permit remains unchanged.

The City's internet-based parking permit system is expected to be available to the public by August.

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
